

INFORMATION FOR VISITORS

Dear Visitor,

During your visit to our factory your security is very important for us.

Please note the safety instructions below and only enter our facility together with your contact person and after registration at the reception.



General notes

The marked footpath may only be left with the permission of the person you are visiting and with appropriate protective clothing.



Protective clothing

You have to wear protective shoes outside the marked footpath.



Admission

You will be met at the reception area by the person you are visiting. You are not authorized to enter any other areas of the factory. The person you are visiting will inform you of further dangers.



Taking photographs

Both taking photographs and filming video footage is prohibited on our premises. Except with prior approval.



Smoking

Smoking is not permitted in the Offices and some production departments.



ATTENTION

Test on our testbed can start anytime, also other machines can start operating at anytime.

Pay attention to truck traffic on the entire factory floor.

Never stand under suspended loads and follow the instructions of our staff.

Alarm

In the event of an alarm please leave the building immediately via the emergency exits and proceed to the designated assembly point.

Please make sure that gates and doors are closed in order to prevent unauthorized access!

BEHAVIOUR IN CASE OF AN ACCIDENT



Next to each hall telephon there is a "Notfallplan" with emergency numbers on it.

1. Call the emergency services

Emergency number **(0)112**

WHAT happened?

WHERE did it happen?

HOW MANY injured people?

WHAT kind of injury?

WAIT for further questions

2. First aid

Make the scene of the accident safe, help the injured people

3. Further actions

Follow the instructions of the emergency personnel and provide them with any relevant information.

BEHAVIOUR IN CASE OF FIRE



1. Report fire

Emergency number **(0)112**

WHO is calling?

WHERE did it happen?

WHAT happened?

2. Seek safety

Take vulnerable people with you, close doors and windows. Take the marked escape routes and proceed to the assembly point.

3. Put out the fire

If safe to do so attempt to put out the fire, never endanger yourself or others while attempting to tackle the fire.
